Year 6 Beaumanor Hall Visit

On Monday 13th November we will be taking our Year 6 students on a visit to Beaumanor Hall in Leicester for a World War II themed day. There will be activities such as code breaking, spending some time in an air raid shelter and experiencing what rationing was like.

We will leave the Academy at 9.00am and return at approximately 3.00pm.

Students who are entitled to free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch. All other students should bring their own lunch, no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.

Full school uniform must be worn.

The cost of this trip will be £10 per pupil. This will cover both the cost of the activities for the day and the coach travel to get to Beaumanor Hall. While in previous years, trips have been free at the Academy, the school is unable to continue to fund this so **unless we receive payment from pupils we will have to cancel the trip for the whole year group**.
