Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to thank you for your continued support for the academy in our drive to improve behaviour for learning. The vast majority of our young people are working with us positively as we embed our TUDOR values into the daily life of the academy. To improve behaviour standards further and to ensure that all our students are taking responsibility for their conduct we have made some amendments to our behaviour expectations.

From Monday 30th October:

- Any student who has to be removed from a lesson for disrupting teaching and learning and is asked to work in the Hotspot room will receive a ½ hour detention at the end of the same school day and parents will be contacted by telephone. If a student fails to attend this detention they will receive a higher sanction authorised by a member of the Senior Leadership Team.
- The parents of any student who has received multiple removals from lessons within the same week will be contacted by the College Leader to arrange a meeting to address the concerns raised.
- Any student refusing to follow an instruction from a senior member of staff can expect to receive a high level sanction.

Of course these amendments do not apply to all those students who regularly work hard in their lessons without disruption and accept the authority of staff. We hope that for those few who do not these changes will help them make the right choices.

I thank you in anticipation of your support with these measures to support teaching and learning within the Academy.
