Dear Parent/Carer

Due to your child's interest and enthusiasm in Science, they have been chosen for a special trip to visit the Think Tank Science Museum in Birmingham. This trip will take place on Tuesday 13 March 2018.

As we have a long way to go, the trip will be outside of normal school hours. **We will be leaving promptly at 7.45 am and will not return until approximately 5.30 pm.** All children will need to be at school for **7.45 am.** **Please note that we will not be able to wait for children who arrive late.** Children will need to be collected on our return to the Academy. While we expect this to be at around 5.30 pm, due to the distance we are travelling, we will find it difficult to be precise. We will regularly update the school office on our progress. Please ring the school office to receive an update of when we expect to arrive back to the Academy.

If you will be unable to ensure your child is at school at this time or are unable to collect them, please let your child's teacher know so that another child can be given the opportunity to attend.

The children will need to wear full school uniform and bring enough food and drink to last them for the day. Those children who have a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch, however I recommend that you also send them with extra drinks and snacks to keep them going as it will be a longer than normal day. No fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10 which we would like to ask you pay via the parent pay system.

While we are at the museum, we will be able to explore the wide range of interactive exhibits and we will be taking part in a special workshop called, 'Destination space!' It will be a fantastic opportunity and an enjoyable day.
