We expect parents to make routine doctor and dentist appointments outside the school day and bring children to school before or after an appointment where possible. For all medical appointments to be authorised school will request to see and take a copy of the appointments letter/card or text.

If you are planning a family holiday, please make every effort to take this during school holidays. If you are unable to do so, please ensure that you obtain authorisation before you book- send your request into the office. Schools rarely agree to parents taking their children out of school for the purposes of a holiday in term-time and we follow the Government legislation on absence requests.
