1) End of term arrangements

The Academy will be closed to all pupils for the duration of the Easter holiday and the school day will finish from 12pm on Friday 22nd March 2024. It is important all pupils attend school on this day. We have planned a Easter egg hunt for each class in Primary.

2) Start of term arrangements:

3) Uniform and appearance – preparation for April

1. Footwear:

 \cdot Shoes should be plain black leather with a maximum heel height of 5cm and maximum sole thickness of 2cm (heel is measured from the ground to the welt up the back of the heel.

 \cdot No coloured logo. Boots are also not allowed.

2. Trousers/skirts:

 \cdot Trousers or skirts must be charcoal grey, not black. Skirts should be no shorter than knee length.

3. Socks and tights:

· Tights and socks should be dark grey or black.

4. Hairstyles and piercings:

 \cdot Pupils are not allowed to wear ear, noise, tongue, or other piercings. If they have any visible piercings or retainers these must be removed before the school day.

 \cdot The use of a plaster to cover any of these items is also prohibited.

Nail varnish and nail or eyelash extensions are not permitted.

- · Hair should be kept neat and tidy, and any hair accessories should be small.
- · Extreme hairstyles e.g., unnatural colours or patterns are not allowed.
- · Hair or eyebrows should not be shaved with lines.

Please be mindful of this expectation as pupils tend to get new hairstyles and piercings over the holidays. Pupils will be removed from social times until these issues are corrected.

Punctuality is important. Please be aware that AM registration is at **8.30am** so it is important that pupils are in school for **8.20am**. If, for whatever reason, your child will be arriving late please call Students Services 0116 2780232 to inform them.
