

Tudor Grange Samworth Academy – Consultation on Admissions Policy

In accordance with the School Admissions Code 2014, the Tudor Grange Samworth Academy is required to consult on their admissions arrangements at least every 7 years. Attached is a copy of the draft Admissions Policy for the Academy.

We are proposing that the majority of the admissions arrangements remain the same, however we are proposing to add at Paragraph 3 (Procedure for allocating places, including dealing with over subscription), the following:

Admission of children outside their normal age group:

Parents may seek a place for their child outside their normal school age group, for example, if their child is gifted and talented, or has experienced problems such as ill health. If parents wish to do this they must contact the Academy. The decision whether a child is admitted outside their normal age group will be made on a case by case basis by the Academy's Local Governing Body.

The consultation process will commence on Monday 11th December 2017 and conclude on Sunday 21st January 2018.
