In partnership with TGSA this 3G will provide an inclusive programme, particularly focussed on female and disabled provision


The 3G will become a beacon of excellence and an FA pilot school demonstrating school and community links to drive exceptional football outcomes





TENNIS CENTRE

The School Planner


What is the planner for?

A place to log warnings (penalties) as well as praise (merits) for learning and attitude to learning


TGSA will provide students with one free planner at the start of the year. Students will be expected to replace their planner if lost or not maintained to an acceptable standard.







