

- TERM 1 -

Early Tension between East and West/Medieval and Renaissance Medicine

Due to recent changes, we'll finish the Cold War early and begin to revise Medicine through Time. We will consolidate our existing knowledge of themes such as ideas about the causes and treatment of disease in the Medieval and Renaissance periods.

- TERM 2 -

Industrial, Modern **Medicine and the Western Front/Anglo-Saxon England and challenges to** William I

We will conclude Medicine through Time by considering the development of medicine since 1900, as well as the impact of the first world war on the development of modern medicine. Then, we will revisit the Norman Conquest in more detail by studying Anglo-Saxon England and early challenges to William I.

- TERM 3 -

Establishment of Norman Control

We will conclude our revision of the Norman Conquest through considering why the Normanisation of England was successful.




