Home Learning – Nursery

Our expectations for Home Learning in Nursery

The early years are critical to developing a lifelong love of reading. Whilst at Nursery we will support your child to develop this love of reading through whole group and individual stories. To help us in this we would like you to share your child's story book with them at least three times a week. However, reading daily would really help develop their understanding of the story. Every Thursday we will share the book again and use questioning about the book to help develop their understanding. They will then receive a new book to share at home.

On Fridays we will send out a home learning journal, with some simple activities for your child to complete over the week. These will be linked to the learning in the class. Please feel free to put other learning into the journal or photographs of exciting things the children have done over the week. Please return this in their book bag every Thursday so we can share this with the rest of the class.

We will be rewarding our children with stickers for their chart for all work completed.
