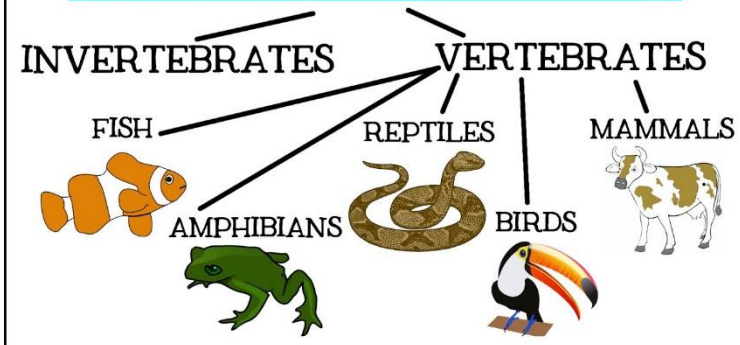
carnivore	Animals that eat meat.
herbivore	Animals that eat plants.
omnivore	Animals that eat plants and meat.
diet	The food and water we eat.
habitat	A natural home for an animal, plant or other living organism.
Reptile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lays eggs - Dry, scaly skin
Amphibian	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lives on land or in water - Lays eggs in water.
Fish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Live in water. - Have fins, scales and gills.
Mammal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have fur or hair - Give birth to live young. - Produce milk for their babies.
Bird	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have feathers, wings and a beak. - Lay eggs - Usually able to fly.
pets	Friendly animals trained to live with humans.
young	An animal's baby or babies.
