Year 1: Claude Monet


Techniques and Materials:

Monet used a lot of oil paints in his work but also did many drawings.

Monet watched nature and drew what he saw, using darker lines to show where the light was.

He used a sharper pencil for thin lines and a blunt pencil for thick ones.





Key vocabulary:

Landscape – A picture of a natural place.

Impressionism – A type of art that shows a moment in time.

Sketch – A rough drawing.

Tone – How light or dark a colour is.
