
Year 2: Guiseppe Arcimboldo

Knowledge:

Guiseppe Arcimboldo was born in Italy in 1527.

He is best known for creating portraits made from objects like fruit and vegetables.

Some of his most famous pieces are called Four Seasons. These images are created using fruit that is grown during each season.





Key Questions:

Can you place objects to create an image?

Can you use line and tone to represent objects?

Can you use a range of drawing techniques?

Techniques and Materials:

Arcimboldo created portrait heads made of fruit, vegetables, plants and other objects to look like a person.

Arcimboldo used collage to create an image before painting. He used natural materials along with everyday objects.

He painted these representations onto canvas.





Key vocabulary:

Portrait – A picture of a natural place.

Still life – A type of art that shows a moment in time.

Tone – How light or dark a colour is.

Canvas – a strong material used to paint on.

Hatching – a drawing technique used to create toe
