Year 7 Transition Drama activity


Drama is all about realising the capabilities of your own imagination. It is a chance for you to develop your confidence, communication skills and creativity through exploring characters and stories.



Darkwood Manor activity: In this activity we would like you to complete a storyboard activity based on the image you see below of 'Darkwood Manor.' Imagine what characters you could create? Who would live there? Why does it look/feel so spooky? What happens in your story?



Task1: Create your characters- who are the characters in your story? Draw out and describe the characters in your story- (We have included a template below if you need it). Write their name and three words that describes them (nervous, funny, shy etc).





Task 2: Storyboard activity. In the 6 boxes below, draw out what happens in each part of your story (for example box 1 could start with someone going to explore Darkwood Manor and box 6 would be the end of your story)

Under each image that you draw in the boxes, write a couple of sentences about what is happening. You can write more on a blank sheet of paper if you wish to add more detail!

Be as creative and imaginative as you want! The most interesting pieces of work will win a prize when you return to school!
