Our expectations for Home Learning in Reception.

Reading

This is a key year for building upon the knowledge of phonics your child already has. The expectation is that your child should read at home at least three times a week. **Don't forget to sign their Home Communication book.** Every time a child returns a book to school that you have signed in their diaries they will get a reading raffle ticket and this will enter them into a prize – every week! To win their own book from a choice in the classroom.

Home Learning for the half term will be sent home with your child on the first Friday of the start of a half term in their Home Learning book. These activities will be linked to our Topic for the term. You can choose the activity you complete each week, please return the book to school on a Wednesday each week so that we can share your child's learning with the rest of the class. Practising phonics with your child daily will make a huge impact on their ability to read and learn new words – with this in mind, we will send out phonics home learning weekly for you to complete with your child.

Please keep up to date on Class Dojo as we will use this to notify you of any important events or changes you need to be aware of. If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to speak to the class teacher or myself. We are available in the morning and at the end of the day.
