- TERM 1 -

Component 2: Developing Skills and Techniques within Performing Arts

You will develop knowledge of attributes required to be a successful actor. You will develop physical and vocal knowledge when taking on different characters and gain knowledge of drama techniques. You will learn and perform an extract from Blood Brothers the musical and keep a log of the rehearsal process, including writing 3 milestone reviews.
