- TERM 1 -

Urban Issues and Challenges

During this term, you will begin to study our ever-changing urban world, including the opportunities and challenges that are posed to society and the environment within our urban environments. We will look at an example of a city in a LIC/NEE as well as an urban area in the UK.



LINKS TO PRIOR LEARNING

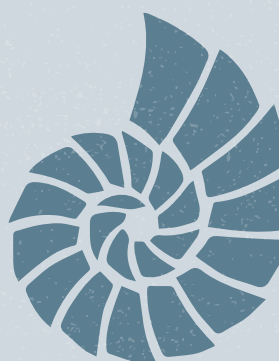

- TERM 2 -

The Changing Economic World

In this term, you will be studying the dynamics of the urban world and how different countries have developed. We will be looking at the economics and politics of specific countries to help deepen our understanding of the changing world around us.



LINKS TO PRIOR LEARNING

The Changing Economic World will compliment various aspects of prior learning, particularly regarding the challenges of resource management as well as many links to urban issues and challenges. From the KS3 curriculum, there can be links to globalisation and challenging cities.



- TERM 3 -

The Living World, Pre-release Study and Exam Preparation

This term, you will be studying the specific features of ecosystems including tropical rainforests and hot deserts. We will be investigating the relationships which humans have on the environment. As well as this, we will be studying a pre-release booklet which will be assessed in Paper 3 and preparing for your final exams in the summer term.
