- TERM 1 -

A Study of the USA and Uganda

During this term, you will be studying key physical and human elements of geography within the USA and Uganda. You will be looking at how climate change can impact on the development of both countries and ways in which both countries have adapted and mitigated some of the impacts.



LINKS TO PRIOR LEARNING

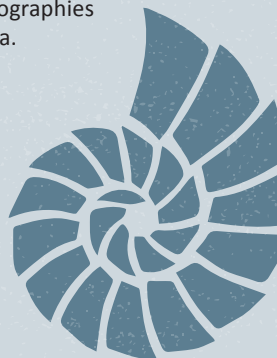
For this term, there are elements of knowledge from previous years (fantastic places, globalisation and Africa is a continent of contrast) that will help support the building of knowledge within these topics.



- TERM 2 -

Around the World

In this term, we will be studying an array of locations across Asia including the Social, Economic, Environmental and Political aspects of each study. We will be studying the effects of resource management (food, energy and water) and linking that to development and conflicts in this part of the world. Throughout, we will study the human and physical geographies of each area.

- TERM 3 -

Cracking Coasts and Wild Water
