School Digital Health and Wellbeing Contact

During the school year 2022/2023 all children in Leicester City in year 9 will be invited to take part in a school digital health and wellbeing contact. Leicestershire Partnership NHS Trust's Healthy Together Public Health Nurses (formerly known as School Nurses) will be helping with the implementation of the contact by providing an electronic link to the school; this digital form is not available to be completed at home. The school will not have access to the answers your child provides. This is an opportunity for your child to discuss any health concerns and to encourage them to take responsibility for their own health from a young age.

The following topics will be covered within the contact:

- Emotional health and wellbeing
- Self-harm, low mood, anxiety
- Bullying
- Online safety
- Healthy Lifestyle
- Smoking/Drugs/Alcohol

- Dental Health
- Immunisations
- Vision
- Exams
- Body Image
- Disability
- Body Changes/Puberty/Relationships/Sexual Health/Child Sexual Exploitation
- Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) (young person's understanding of legality only)
- Forced marriage (young person's understanding of legality only)
- Extremism (young person's understanding of legality only)

The contact will provide interactive advice with clear direction on where your child can access safe and appropriate support if required. Follow up by a member of the Healthy Together Public Health Nursing Team will be provided to your child if significant health concerns are identified. The information provided at this contact will be confidential. All the information from the contact will be held securely on NHS IT systems. Data about key themes only will be shared with Local Authority Public Health Commissioners who commission Public Health Nurse Services, and with schools. This will enable an understanding of local trends and support planning services required in Leicester City for young people and their families. Completed health contact information will only be added to your child's electronic medical records where health concerns are identified. Your GP may have access to this information when health concerns are identified. No individual's information will be given to school staff or other children, and all information will be treated confidentially.

If you DO NOT want your child to take part in this digital health and wellbeing contact, please discuss this with your child. You must then contact your child's school, who will arrange for them not to take part.

If you are happy for your child to take part in the contact then you do not need to do anything. Children themselves can opt out of taking part if they do not want to participate.
