- TERM 1 -

R087 Creating an Interactive Multimedia Product (Controlled Assessment)

Students will start their second piece of controlled assessment of the course. This term focusses on the research aspect of the unit looking at evaluating existing Interactive Multimedia Products, looking at features and components used. They will also learn about the devices used to access the internet and the various connection methods available in order for people to use the internet safely.

The students will link back to the research and evaluation techniques from their exam preparation. They will also apply their knowledge of computer hardware from KS3.



- TERM 2 -

R087 Creating an Interactive Multimedia Product (Controlled Assessment)

This term Year 11 students will focus on planning and designing an Interactive Multimedia Product for a specified client brief, in this case is a Health Fitness. They will use Multimedia software to complete a fully functional five page IMMP incorporating a wide range of assets and components. They will then test their IMMP, make improvements and review their work suggesting areas for future development.

- TERM 3 -

R081 Exam Preparation

This term is spent focussing on getting students exam ready. Students will look at pre planning documentation and learn how to apply these to various given scenarios. They will sit mini assessments and mocks so that they are prepared to sit the exam in early January.
