Sexual Health Education

The Health Education and Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) aspects of PSHE (personal, social, health and economic) education are compulsory in all secondary schools since September 2020. This covers broad areas of relevance and concern to children and young people today. It should ensure that every pupil is guaranteed a PSHE education that covers mental health and wellbeing; physical health (including healthy lifestyles and first aid); learning about safe, healthy relationships and sex (including understanding consent, negotiating life online, intimate relationships).

Next STEPS

It is important to consider the things that help young people flourish into adulthood and get ready to take the next steps after GCSE and beyond. We will look at pathways in education and training towards both university and vocational choices at Post 16. We will investigate our career choice platform: Kudos and create revision timetables for exam preparation.
