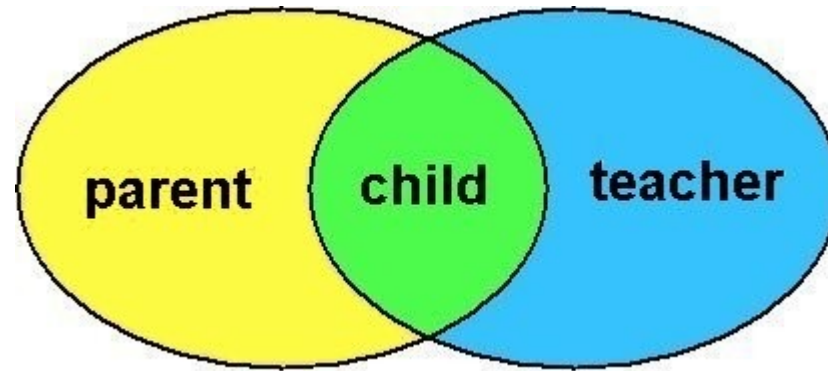

Here are some of the things your child will do in Nursery; this information may help you in your conversations with your child about school, both before and after they start.

Every day we will:

- Sit on the carpet to take the register and talk about the day ahead.
Have Child Initiated and Play Partner Learning - writing activities, number games, activities linked to our current topic, playdough, books, dressing up, small world, arts and crafts and construction. Children will always have access to learning opportunities outside every day.
- Share stories.
- Have access to toast, milk and fruit.

Toothbrushing happens daily in class - we supply all resources for this. Please sign your consent form for this to commence.

Toilet Training - spare clothes to be left in school - no nappies, pull ups are acceptable. Pants are better!

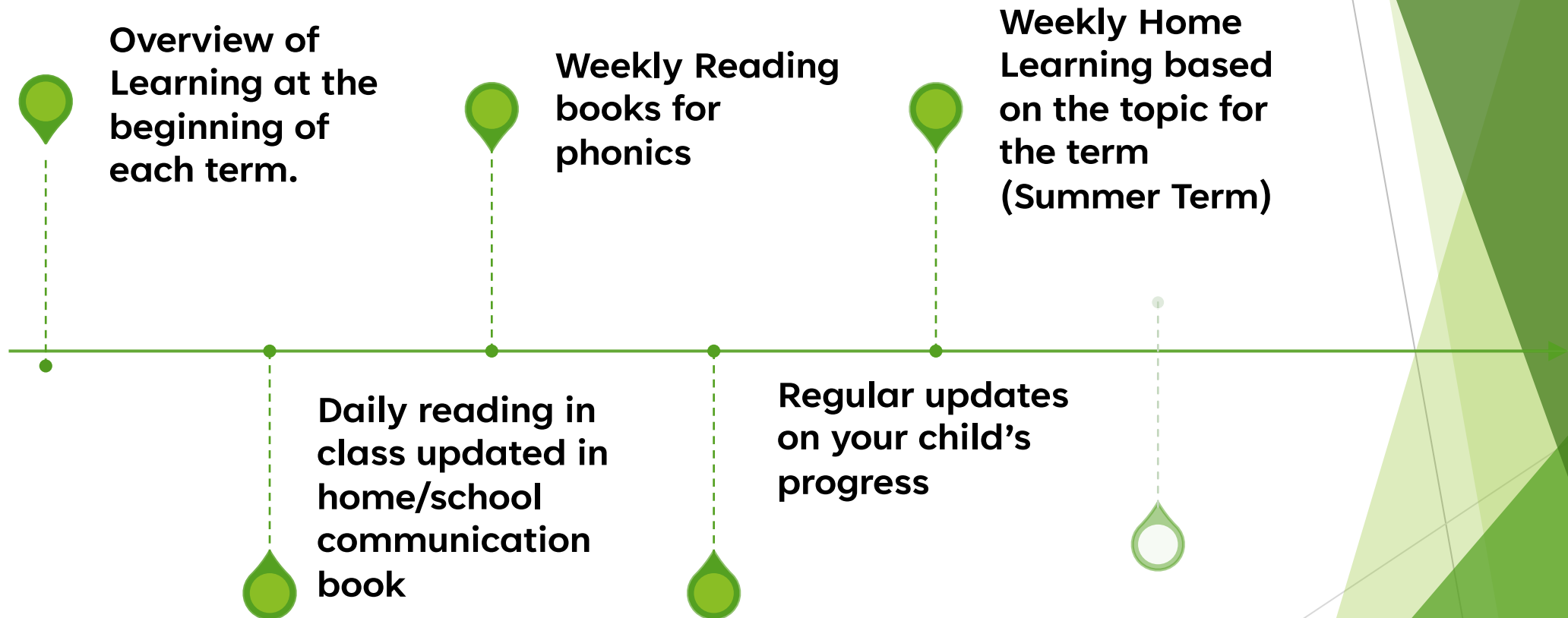
