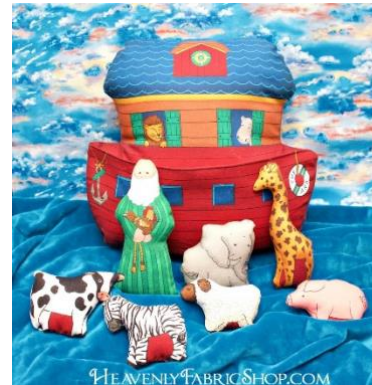

Learning opportunities

During this half term we will be learning about the Bible, what it is and who uses it. We will listen to two Bible Stories.
