Key Vocabulary

Experimental – Where you as the researcher change a variable and observe the effect on other variables.

Leading Question – A questions that suggests or tends to suggest its own answer.

Cleaning Data – Fixing or removing incorrect, corrupted, duplicate or poorly formatted data from a data set.

Bias – Prejudice for or against one person or group, considered unfair.

Ethical – Following moral principles and obtaining knowledge and information in this manner.

Representation – Representative of the entire population.

Hypothesis – A supposition or proposed explanation made based on limited evidence, as a starting point for further investigation.

Variable – An element, feature, or factor that is liable to change.

Predictive Analytics – The use of statistics to make predictions about future outcomes and performance.
